A pallet lift is equipment designed principally for transporting pallets of varying weights and dimensions. It is really imperative to determine beforehand what type of tasks may be necessary before acquiring a new pallet haul. In a plant with narrow aisles or constricted spaces, picking a pallet haul that is able to maneuver down the aisles might be the best decision. If the stockroom already has an overhead haul currently mounted, then conceivably, an accessory for the existing haul may be the best alternative.
