Trainees receive practical instruction on different kinds of forklifts. Safety procedures are a major focus of the training. A written test and driving test must be successfully completed before a forklift certification card is given. The forklift certification designation could be transferred to work performed on a lift truck with any employer, which makes it convenient for those looking for a forklift operator job.
