There are different ways to acquire forklift training. Programs are offered through workforce training agencies, company forklift certification programs, and approved video and online courses. The price could be minimal (or free) when offered by occupational safety officers on job sites or through employment agencies.

Forklift operators need to be 18 years of age or over, in most nations. Local industry bodies approve Loader Training courses and require operators to acquire a certificate prior to using this kind of heavy machines. A certificate is valid for four years in nearly all areas. Businesses that hire workers to drive forklift trucks could face serious liability problems if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators can lead to serious injuries and property damage due to incorrect utilization of the equipment. Training covers the correct driving and loading methods. Workers must pass a written test in order to be certified. A business will usually assign a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new employees. A qualified supervisor must have extensive training in forklift safety and be licensed as a trainer.
